#### INTRODUCTION:

To Grandstand means to put more show into a play than is necessary -- to draw applause from the grandstand. Hence it is done to draw applause or make an impression.

This is often a key delight of the athletic field. The player will make a difficult play look easy. A player sometimes risk a close play.

(Human nature is expressed in this way through other channels. In Politics -- a man plays to the crowd and forgets the rules of honesty.

Self Grandeur notes the same thing. Displaying ones eminence, pride rules in all actions. The Pride of A Peacock is the glory of God - wm. Blake

Pride is the Master Sin of the Devil - Ed. Chapin

Paul said the same thing in Eph. 2:9. "Not of works, lest any man should boast".

If we could save ourselves by our own good works -- grandstanding - it would not have been necessary for Christ to have died, and we would have reason to boast of what we DANIEL Defore - "Pride is the First peer AND President of HeLL!"

Verse 1 - Merodach - Heard he had been sick.

Sent - 1. Letters.

- 2. Gifts.
- 3. Curiosity 2 Chron. 32:31 Wonder of the sun dial.
- 4. Additional Reason Get rid of Assyrian yoke.

This was a sick visit. Some friend of yours is ill you send them a card or letter. Often you send a gift of flowers, fruit, or candy. Some go to investigate the illness - wonder - curiosity - want to know what the disease is and some of the details. There are additional reasons as was the case of the Babylonians. Some Preachers run around to attend the sick in another flock with the hope of sheep stealing. The little lamb will say in a critical fashion my Preacher did not visit me but Brother so and so came three times. The chances are the little lambs Pastor did not know of his illness.

This is one of the ministries committed to the church -- care for the sick - visit those in afflictions, writer of James says.

Refreshing to the sick to know that a visit is the result of Christian love and concern. Curiosity visitors are of little comfort to the physically sick. However, a sincere visit bathed in prayer is following the footsteps of Jesus - He went about doing good.

True Christians rejoice with friends, neighbors, fellow church members upon deliverance from the sick bed. A recovery from sickness is a time to praise God.

## II. Searching Question - Verse 3-4

Verse 3 - Prophet - What did they say?

Where did they come from?

What did they see?

Prophet comes unsent for to rebuke the King.

Isaiah had heard about the visit and desired Hezekiah confess. The King told him the truth - He was not ashamed - glories in it.

These idolatrous enemies of God - forbidden to make alliance with - He had received with gladness. Depend on Babylon, not on God!

King had not made the best of their visit.

# Verse 4 / What have they seen in Thine house?

Your question - my question - young people - young married - what?

Take this text out of its contents and put the plain question in reference to your house.

Would strangers visiting your home know that you were a Christian or pagan?

Visitors get an impression - how would a trip, unexpectedly by guests from a far country impress folks?

Now be truthful, what would they see in your house - just to help your memory in the living room, what kind of pictures are on the wall and the type of magazines on the table? Would they see cheap storied magazines with half dressed women? Would a Bible be in view?

In the den would they see a bar? You get the idea -- move on to the kitchen, would beer appear in the ice box? Adam - Paradice Was Lome - Garden - God come to Visit - Jount Sin - Joy gone -

And often has a great share in The Little home - have a Hool - Home is sweet.

Boso in Home - farmer - Determined find a comming who was Boss in each Home - Hitch Harses Wagon - Number Chickens,? Who was Boss wife - Husband Both Admit Wife - give Chickens thinkly - Arient Ausband Bors - all right - which how block or gray? Historial - Black! Then wife Called Next Room conf - Husband returned we decided take gray horse - No you wont said of fame you do get a chicken!

Look in your medicine cabinet—are you depending upon drugs for your kicks in life?

You would say to me well but some of these things are acceptable and even endorced by the Chamber of Commerce!

### III. Specific Word - Verse 5-8.

Verse 5 - Hear the word of the Lord - King was not to listen for man's word - or voice of custom - crowd.

King - boasts of his treasures.

Complacency - relying upon their power.

Visitors may prove to be thieves.

This was result of his folly.

Answer to pride - hear - word - specific.

Buther The people together men, women, thicken, stranger that they may hear the bord of the took

Verse 6 - Specific news of his house.

Gold you are proud of will be carried away to Babylon. Literally - Day approaching.

We miss great opportunities in our life.

A time of bearing witness for God, but we are more interested in personal desires.

Your Motto - "For Christ's Sake".

Hezekiah - heard of the ruin of his seed and successors in his kingdom.

Verse 7 - "Unborn Sons" - At that time - Eunuchs in Babylon - Manasseh - Amariah - their seed.

Daniel 1:2-3. (Descendants) - Fulfilled.

History tells of the fulfillment of this prophecy. Punishment did not fall on the King personally. But a part went to his seed.

The nation was corrupt with pride and apostasy. 120 years afterwards this was carried out. Jews were carried to Babylon, riches carried away.

We cannot see all that is come - but we know of judgment upon vanity, complacency.

Those with an acquaintance who is irreligious and godless - it would do well for you to repent and have no happy relations with Babylon, another of harlots, and of idolatries.

# Verse 8 - "Good is the word of the Lord".

At least Hezekiah is an example to us in the way we should repent and receive God's word reproving our sins.

Prophet had said "Behold the days will come -- nothing left". God mercifully spared the King this tragedy, but Judah continued her sinful way and finally it became a grim reality.

It can happen here in America. It is not far fetched to say with Toynbee the historian of 21 world civilizations - 19 have fallen and they all committed suicide - died within. Luxurious living, pagan in religious matters, taxes soared, corruption in public life - hollow shell.

The only thing that can save us is Repentance and genuine Christian living.

Righteousness is absolutely necessary. This must begin with you!

Word of God is good in that sin is made to be sin. True spiritual life was revealed.

Word of God is good if we receive the rebuke of the word.

Word of God is good if men see their sins and discover the remedy.

History repeats itself - today. Have we not received many precious things of truth?

Have we not looked upon wealth as our very own -- "I am rich and increased in goods". Using it as a means of self-exaltation.

Church - Laodicea - proud - false hope - I will spew the out.

Samson - Philistines not interested in his true wealth - physical power.

Word of God is good if you cease grandstanding and play the game of life by the rules of truth.

The Pharisees were great at play acting - Jesus condemned.

If King Hezekiah instead of showing his gold and silver had given them the account of his marvellous healing, and the miracle of the shadow going back 10 degrees, he might have been the means of bringing them to the knowledge of the true God who made Heaven and earth.
