From age 45 up - that mine made Intro: Disaster is a headline word in every news paper in 1940 the country. A fire destroyed a 100,000.00 warehouse, People and cattle are snow bound, a river breaks over & washes a bridge away, at a crossing on highway 80 three people were killed-- Disaster-- The man down the street died last night-- on and on

How do we face it all? what is our reaction to disaster? When it comes to us, how ell do we stand up under it?

Do you give up? - Don't give up. Do you give up? - Don't give up. Here before us is a story from the Bible-- How a person capitalised the leavings of disaster.

I. A WOMAN AND DISASTER V.1

- 1. Husband died... lost her companion etc.
- 2. A debt
- A. Anyone with sturdy independence finds a debt galling.
- B. Some people through no fault of our own get in debt--
MRS HARVEY the discoverer of the circulation of the blood, had her physician to James I a chemist, in 1628. She was in all circumstances a good wife & a good mother. She had a good son who came to great office, but unfortunately died at 28. She was not a full and a great discoverer for medical science.
- 3. The Creditor....
Under Law could take her two boys into slavery for 7 years.
Without principle-urged the payment of the debt then,

4. Her two sons....
Desperate straits, these two boys could support her & in time pay off the debt, but if taken as slaves she would be left without support.

II. A PROPHET TO HER AID.

1. Heard her story of grief - v.1

2. Ask her one Question *"WHAT HAST THOU IN THE HOUSE?"

Is there anything left of value in this situation?

Elisha did not come with a shower of aid in abundance, but sought to help her help herself. This is a true way to help the poor - reckless almsgiving ruins the objects of our charity.

3. A pot of oil - v.2

Even in the worst situation we have a little to live for.

4. Borrow - v.3

5. Close the door - & pour - v.4-6

6. Pay your debt - v.7

This is taking the scanty left overs and succeeding that was ruining her happiness

III. LEAVINGS OF DISASTER

There is always something of value in the leavings of disaster. This bereaved woman had more when she finished than just a little pot of Oil.

1. She discovered she had a real friend in a day of disaster

Prophet Elisha - He respected her husband for his faith and service

He could tell her right

She could counsel first with the man who knew God!

2. She discovered sympathetic neighbours in the day of Disaster

Who were ready to help - let her have their vessels

Frid. Oct 9, 1913 While Joe & Martha Hall were in classes at Bluefield College the drought year of the great fire little home. James consumed the little home & contents. His furniture, wedding gifts, mining outfit, books & clothes completely destroyed. Joe a minister, student, & mother, his wife, were left with only the clothes they were wearing. He sought to buy second clothes, the business people immediately - The family! The parents home & found her home in a spare bedroom in the parents home. He found her started to help at home in home helping again. "Howlow But Not Forget Her Had him & article in the Herald."

3. She discovered the tie of love in her family

The family held loyally together - and stood side by side in the hard struggle.

The boys worked with their mother till the shadows of the debt vanished
